BECAUSE BEADS ARE UBIQUITOUS . . .

CHANDELIER NECKLACE: Chandelier findings aren't just for earrings - they also can be used to make one heck of a necklace.

Supplies: round 3-way dangles; 22 g wire, large lucite leaves; drop beads, spacers and/or caps, 6 & 8mm beads; 6 & 6mm jump rings; chain; clasp.

DINNER RING: Simple, yet elegant. You're sure to get compliments whenever you wear this ring.

Supplies: 6mm round crystal; 11° beads, 8° beads, beading thread, size 10 needles.

NEOLITHIC CENTERPIECE: Double-drilled stone beads come front and center in this dramatic focal design.

Supplies: five 10x20mm double-drilled stone beads, 22 g. (or heavier) headpins; assorted

beads or charms, daisy spacers, chain, clasp, jumprings.

CASUAL STYLE: Here's a couple of bracelets and a necklace that are quick to make and fun to wear. The necklace is a great project to show off Kazuri beads.

Supplies: assorted large-hole beads; beads for charms and/or charms; 1.5mm leather or waxed cord; S hooks; large links; headpins; 2-hole or shank button.

HARLEQUIN BRACELET: Use twin beads to create this bracelet with a bold, diamond pattern. There is something particularly appealing about the way these beads feel when they are woven into a fabric like this.

Supplies: two colors of twin beads; 11° & 15° seed beads; two-strand bar/tube clasp.
